The natural progression of "passing" students (those with grades of "C" or higher) is to move from **A Level** to **B Level** of the same course, **B Level** to **A Level** of the next, **A Level** to **B Level** of the next, and so on.

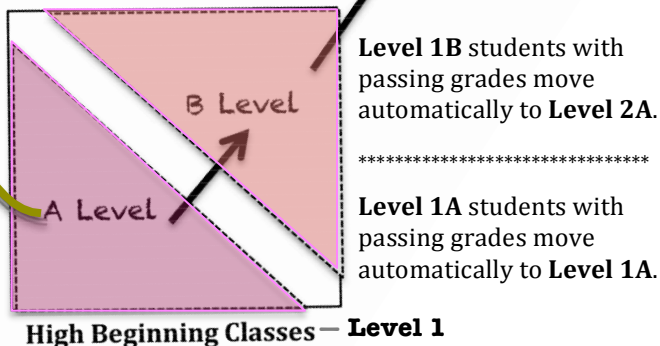
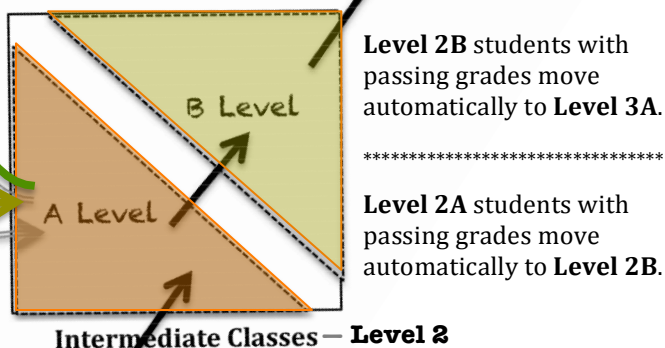
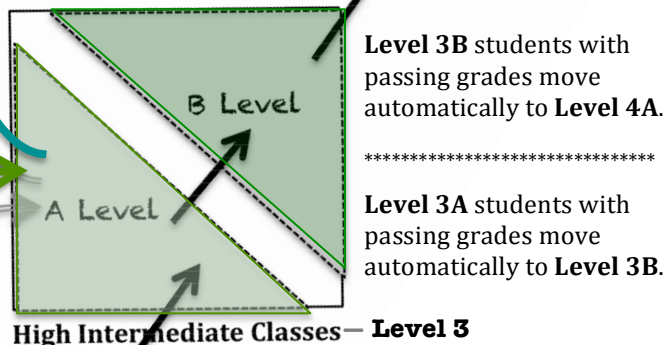
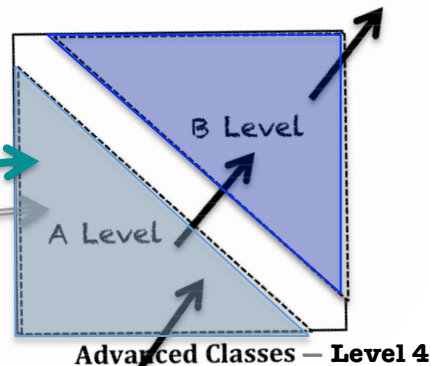
A Level students identified for acceleration may (but are not required to) skip the **B Level** of their current class to move to the **A Level** of the next higher course in the skill area sequence.

Both **A Level** and **B Level** students with grades of "D" or "F" must repeat their current level before proceeding through the program.

Accelerated **Level 3A** students skip **Level 3B** to enter **Level 4A**.

Accelerated **Level 2A** students skip **Level 2B** to enter **Level 3A**.

Accelerated **Level 1A** students skip **Level 1B** to enter **Level 2A**.



Level 3B students with passing grades move automatically to **Level 4A**.

Level 3A students with passing grades move automatically to **Level 3B**.

Level 2B students with passing grades move automatically to **Level 3A**.

Level 2A students with passing grades move automatically to **Level 2B**.

Level 1B students with passing grades move automatically to **Level 2A**.

Level 1A students with passing grades move automatically to **Level 1A**.
